Part 1. Registration Notice and FAQs

Q1. What information I can get from this document?

As shown in the catalogue, this document is comprised of three parts:

- Registration Notice and FAQs: aiming to answer questions that you may have during the registration process.
- SRS Registration Guidance: demonstrating the step-by-step procedures of using our registration portal to complete the exam registrations.
- <u>Information Sheets</u>: including information like registration timeline, option codes of most available subjects, exam timetable, and exam fee list of different entry stages.

Please go through this document and make sure that you understand and accept the content of this document before you submit registrations. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact us. Once the payment of your exam application is completed, you are not allowed to modify your registrations. You are responsible for any mistakes of the registrations due to your own reasons.

Q2. Are there any regulations on the ID I use for registration?

British Council only accepts the following identity documents for exam registration and sitting:

- Chinese nationals from mainland China can register with a valid and current 2nd-generation national ID card or passport.
- Chinese nationals from Hong Kong and Macau can register with a valid and current ID card, passport or Hong Kong and Macau Residents' Residence Permit.
- <u>Chinese nationals from Taiwan</u> can only register with a valid and current Mainland Travel Permit for Taiwan Residents of China or Taiwan Residents' Residence Permit.
- Foreign nationals can register with a valid and current passport.
- * Please use the correct and valid ID document for registration. Candidates must bring the identification document used for registration to attend the exams.
- *British Council reserves the right to disallow candidates to take the examination if the identification document does not conform to the regulations.

Q3. Can I register Pearson Edexcel exams at different test centres?

Within the same exam series, candidates can register for exams of different subjects at different centres, but not allowed to register for exams of the same subject at different centres. Please also note that if you register for exams at different centres within the same exam series, it may lead to problems such as failure to rearrange timetable clash or to accurately carry forward results from this session. Thus, registering for all exams at one test centre is highly recommended.

Q4. What happens when there are timetable clashes between Pearson Edexcel exams and other exams I register?

• For timetable clash between multiple subjects of Pearson Edexcel exams registered at our centre, we will make re-arrangement accordingly. Candidates should refer to the Confirmation Letter for the final timetable.

If there is any timetable clash between two exams, one of them will be rescheduled for a different time on the same date. Candidates sitting these two exams will be under full centre supervision between exams, during which time they will not be permitted to use mobile phones nor any other electronic devices or communicate with the other candidates.

 We are unable to make any rearrangement for timetable clash between Pearson Edexcel exams registered at our centre and other exams (e.g. Cambridge International). Candidates should avoid any timetable clash before registering for exams.

Q5. Can I apply for Access Arrangements due to my disadvantaged health conditions?

Candidates may face barriers to exams if they have a permanent or long-term disability, illness or learning difficulties, or a temporary disability or illness. Access arrangements are pre-exam arrangements that allow candidates to access the assessment and remove unnecessary barriers. Candidate who has demands in this regard, please contact us for more details as early as possible and provide required evidence when applying for Access Arrangements.

Deadline for application: Please refer to the Information Sheets.

* Candidates must send us access arrangements application for each exam series. We cannot carry over the approval from pervious exam series.

Q6. Will my exam fee be refunded if I would like to cancel my exam registrations?

According to the refund policy, applicant who submits a refund request that meets the refund conditions and provides valid evidences with the official seal before the deadline is entitled to receive the refund that is in accordance with the refund standard once the refund request is approved.

- Deadline for Refund Application: Before the deadline of late entry stage (deadline of late entry stage can be found on Information Sheets)
- Acceptable Refund Conditions:
 - o Condition 1: Temporary physical or mental illness (permanent or long-term illness is not acceptable)
 - o Condition 2: Time clash with school exams or other official exams
- Evidences Required :
 - Condition 1: Evidence can be a medical report or accident report (or similar), which should be issued by an authorised body. The report should include both the signature of the doctor or professional and stamp of the institution as well as indicate how the situation prohibits the candidate from taking the exam on the scheduled date.
 - o Condition 2: The evidence can be the statement with the official seal of the school or the confirmation letter of the official exams.
- Refund Standard:
 - o Once the refund application is approved, the applicant can receive 150 CNY for each unit.
 - o For International GCSE exams, candidates can only apply for cancellation by option (e.g., 4CN1), not by unit (e.g., 4CN1/01)

Refund applications out of other conditions are not acceptable. You can contact us to get more details.

Q7. Can I transfer my registrations to other exam centres after I finish the payment?

- Deadline for application: Before the deadline of late entry stage (deadline of late entry stage can be found on Information Sheets)
- The principle of transfer: Candidates cannot transfer to another centre for specific syllabuses or components. They can only transfer for all their assessments in an exam series.
- Transfer between exam centres may incur extra payment. Please contact us for more details.

A unique candidate identifier (UCI) is a reference that's unique to a candidate and lasts for the duration of their study career. It's used to aggregate unit results for modular exams. Without it, candidates may not be given their full results. It can be found in the Statement of Entry and the Provisional Statement of Results. For the first time test taker, the UCI will be created by the centre and please input "NA" in UCI section in the registration system. While for the other candidates, please keep using the previous UCI in all the exam session.

*The Pearson Edexcel and OxfordAQA exam have their own UCI number. You must fill in the correct UCI number in the registration.

Q9. What is Cash-in of Pearson Edexcel International A/AS Level exams?

The cash-in process is used to aggregate the candidate's unit scores to obtain the overall grade for the qualification. No grade can be issued unless the appropriate cash-in code is entered.

* It is strongly recommended that you to submit the Cash-in code during the exam application. You can receive a new grade once you retake the unsatisfied unit and submit the Cash-in code again in the future exam session. The late Cash-in request after the result release will charge you additional fee and it may affect your university application as it takes at least 10 working day to process.

For the general cash-in rule, the exam board will maximize the qualification grades automatically. For more details about cash-in rule, please refer to the official information below:

Q10: Are my Pearson Edexcel results of each unit and qualification only valid for a set number of years? All the results and qualifications remain valid.

Q11: Will the statement of results and certificate show all my pervious results?

Only the score of each unit registered in current session, the grades of AS/A-Level and the score of each unit cashed in to AS/A-Level will be displayed on the Candidate Provisional Statement of Results. If you are absent, the "X" is displayed only which indicates no result. As to the certification, it only displays your final grade of certain subject awarded in the current session.

Part 2. SRS Registration System Guidance

The Schools Registration Systems (SRS) is the online registration platform offered to private candidates (over 18) and parents/guardians of minor candidates (under 18) to support them to complete their registration journey to register for Cambridge International exams, Pearson Edexcel exams and OxfordAQA exams with the British Council. The registration journey may differ according to countries based on each country's local context and regulations.


Step 03: Search for exams



- Awarding body: Select "Cambridge International", "Pearson Edexcel" or "OxfordAQA",
- **Session:** Select session, for example "Nov 2022"
- Qualification Level: Select "A-Level" or "IGCSE" (if you wish to register A2 Level and AS Level exams please choose "A-Level")
- Location: Select "Beijing", "Shanghai", "Guangzhou" or "Chongqing"
- Subjects: Select Subjects. For subject details, please check Part 3: Exam Information Sheet.







At the end of the examination, candidates need to wait in the designated area of the test center for pick up. Invigilator needs to check the identity of the pickup person then handover the candidate and the pickup person needs to sign for confirmation. On test day, the pick-up person should bring his/her ID card to the test center, please cooperate with the invigilator for this process. If you are confident that the candidate can leave the test center by themself, please select "Yes I give my permission".
 - o Please click on "The child will be over 18 at exams day" if the candidate will turn 18 years old on test day.



- If you choose the option with carry forward (only applicable to A2 options and part of full A Level options), please select "Carry forward", and enter the center number, candidate number and session information of the test session that you achieved the AS result. If you choose to carry forward the AS results for two sessions, please fill in the latest one.
 - o For example: Previous center number is *CN004*, and previous candidate number is *0100*. This information can be found on the Statement of Entry or Provisional Statement of Result of the corresponding test session.
 - o Please note that AS level results are valid only for 13 months. For example, in Oct/Nov 2022 session, only AS results achieved in the May/June 2022 and Oct/Nov 2021 session are valid.
 - o If the option is both carry forward and retake, the pervious center number and candidate number of May/June session of the

same year should be entered by default. If you would like to carry forward the AS result achieved in Oct/Nov session, please send us the relevant information via email.

- [Only applicable to Oct/Nov exam series] If you tick the "Retake" in Step 4, the subject will be selected "Retake" by default here. You need to enter the previous center number, candidate number and test season information here.
 - Previous center number and previous candidate number must be the information of the May/June session of the same year;
 This information can be found on the Statement of Entry or Provisional Statement of Result.
 - o Previous session is the May/June session of the same year by default and cannot be changed.
- Your registration will be failed if you do not have AS result, or your AS result is expired or carried forward to the wrong combination.
- If you tick the retake incorrectly, you will be asked to pay the late entry penalty.

For Pearson Edexcel exams and OxfordAQA exams ONLY:




- If you sat for the Pearson Edexcel exam or OxfordAQA exam before, please click "Yes" and fill in the UCI number. If it is your first time to take the exam, please select "No".
- UCI (Unique Candidate Identifier) is a 13-digits code, e.g. 92902B210660Z. You can find the UCI in your pervious Statement of Entry or Provisional Statement of Result.
- The Pearson Edexcel and OxfordAQA exam have their own UCI number. You must fill in the correct UCI number in the registration. If you have more than one UCI number of one exam board, please contact us to merge UCI numbers.
- The "Standard" option is the default registration option of Pearson Edexcel exams and OxfordAQA exams.
- For IAS and IAL qualification, you must submit the correct cash-in code to receive an overall grade of each subject. Please refer to **Part3: Information Sheet** for more details about the cash-in rule.






