

Innovating with AI: Pedagogical Workflows for English Language Teaching:

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Overview

This session explores how English language teachers can design complete lesson workflows using Artificial Intelligence — from authentic listening input to differentiated student output. Through practical demonstrations, participants will see how AI can enhance lesson planning, creativity, accessibility, and engagement while reducing teacher workload.

The workflow connects six key tools to show how AI can support every stage of the learning cycle:

Turboscribe → ChatGPT / DeepSeek → Suno → Immersive Reader → Brisk Podcasts → Diffit

Together, these tools demonstrate how teachers can transform input materials into multimodal learning resources that develop listening, reading, speaking, and writing skills.

Focus of the Session

- Practical use of free, accessible AI tools
- Pedagogical workflows for planning and practice
- Creating authentic and inclusive learning experiences
- Ethical and responsible classroom use of AI

Summary of Key Messages

This session showed how teachers can begin with an authentic listening clip and, through connected AI tools, generate a sequence of learning activities across all four skills. The approach saves planning time, encourages creativity, and keeps learning authentic. AI supports teachers by streamlining content creation while maintaining clear pedagogical intent. Each tool contributes to a coherent input-to-output workflow that promotes learner engagement, differentiation, and accessibility.

Start small by trialling one or two tools and adapt the process to your own teaching context.
